Tea/Coffee, Bakes and a Raffle

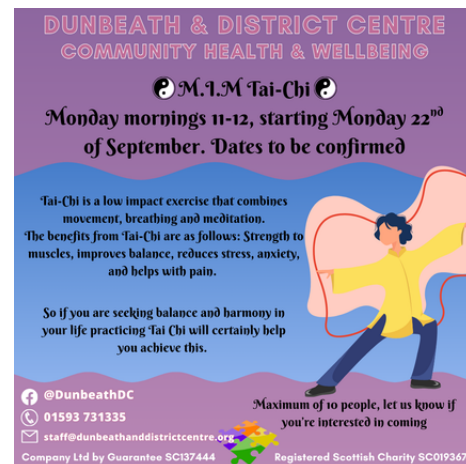
We have strollers group every Thursday meeting in the centre car park at 10:30am.
