IT Advice Returns

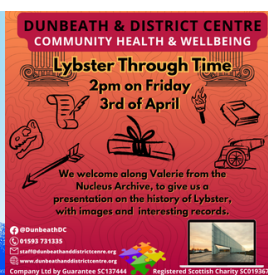
